First of all, the Bracebridge Tennis Club Board would like to thank you for your patience and understanding during this transitional period as we make the move to our new facility.

We are all frustrated by the delays due to weather and shortages of construction materials. However, the construction of the courts is proceeding steadily now and we are optimistic that the Kerr Park courts will be completed in the very near future.

The Town and members of the community, particularly our youth who are enjoying the new facilities at Kelvin Grove, have expressed their gratitude to the BTC for the willingness to make the move and to remain flexible as the work continues.

Optimistic that the courts will be completed in the next two weeks, we are prepared to begin scheduling league play with some adjustments to our initial plan. We are asking our schedulers to draw up an initial schedule for the last week of June and the first week of July (June 28-July 9.) A second schedule will be created in early July for the period of July 12-30.

We will be scheduling 3 courts for play wherever we have the numbers to do so. Please understand, should construction work or covid enforcement require us to do so, we will be cancelling play on one or more courts. We ask for your cooperation and understanding as we move forward.
