


Show Up 'n Play Protocol

Show Up 'n Play gives all members, regardless of ability, the opportunity to play tennis in a fun and relaxed atmosphere.

When there are 5 or more players, please use this protocol to allow players to play with a variety of people and keep the rotation moving (unless there are 6 players and 2 wish to play singles instead of waiting on the bench):

Here is how the players should set up for the opening game:



- 1. Player 1 is the starting point for the rotation in the add court closest to the parking lot.
- 2. Player 2 starts in the deuce court, same end.
- 3. Player 3 starts in the add court, opposite player 2.
- 4. Player 4 is the server, and starts in the deuce court opposite player 1.
- 5. The rotation moves in a counter clockwise direction at the end of each game:
 - The server rotates out and sits at end of bench.
 - The first player on bench moves into position 1.
- 6. If there is more than one court:
 - The courts rotate independently of each other.
 - Every 30 minutes players from the bench move to other court.

Please note:

- Play out one deuce, then a sudden death point to keep play moving.
- Non-members are required to pay a \$5 guest fee. If they show up more than 3 times then
 they should be encouraged to join the club. Any guest fees paid will be deducted from
 membership fee (per minutes May 15, 2016 Executive meeting).
